General Operating Procedures

Revised April 1991



The ChicagoLand Glider Council shall elect, bi-annually, at the March Meeting, slate of officers to conduct the business of the Council according to the will and direction of the general membership.

The board shall consist of the following officers, each serving a two year term. Directors will also server a two year term until relieved by the next officer (there are no restrictions on successive terms for any office):

- President
- Vice President
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- Immediate Past President
- Directors

The duties of the officers and Board of Directors shall be to conduct the business of the ChicagoLand Glider Council with special emphasis on;

- Fall/Winder Programs
- The continuity and development of the ChicagoLand Glider Council
- Promoting the sport of Soaring

As part of the continuity and development of the Council, the Board of Directors shall, each year, recommend a slate of two officers for the following year, to be voted on at the March meeting of the general membership. In odd years the President and Secretary will be nominated, in even years the Vice-President and Treasurer will be nominated. This recommendation does not preclude nominations from any other member of the council.

Other duties of the board of Directors shall include conducting an open business meeting as part of each Fall/Winter program meeting. Additionally, the Board of Directors shall meet at least one time between May and October, and as necessary between October and April. Results of all such meetings will be reported to the general membership at the next scheduled program meeting.
