






A Trip Through Memory Lane



POWERED CHEROKEE II (N12042)


This twin-engined sailplane, built by Ken Flagler, 38, lab technician of Northbrook, Ill., from Stan Hall's plans, utilizes the latest West Bend Go-Kart engines turning new 2' diameter Troyer props. The power units were adapted and tested by Sandy Hudson Jr. (see Air Progress' '63 coverage of EAA). Ken, an old-time sailplane and home-builder enthusiast, built the Cherokee over an 8 year period at \$1000 cost; made first hop in June '64. The props, one right hand and one left hand rotation, are of laminated and clear varnished birch, built to specs by K. R. Troyer of Troyer Boats, Comstock Park, Mich. Troyer also made props for Heath and Pietenpol during the '30s. Span 40', length 21'; wing area 125 sq. ft.; empty weight 375-lb, gross 580; engines two-10-hp West Bend Model 82001-1 and 82002-1 Power Bees; top speed 72-mph at 7400 rpm, cruise 60 at 6500-rpm; best climb speed 45-mph at 6400 rpm; take-off run from (paved runway) 900'; landing speed 35-mph; rate of climb 250 ft/min; glide ratio (no power) 16.5 to 1 at 45-mph; sink speed (no power) 4 ft/sec; powered endurance 1-hr; fuel, two gallons of 80-87 octane gas mixed with Kiekhaefer Mercury oil (1-20 oil/gas ratio).




Ken checks engine run-up while his brother Chuck (also a home-builder) looks on. Engine starts at Rockford were via outboard recoil starter but Ken plans to add small pulley cables to allow operation from cockpit. Streamlined engine mounts are also expected to raise top speed to 75-mph and prop spinners to increase engine rpm to 7500-plus.



The fuel tanks located behind the pilot are plastic.



The cockpit controls include a single tachometer to serve both engines, using a toggle selector switch. Tach is a Sun transistor electric type requiring only a self-contained small mercury battery. Only hook-up required is a switch cut-off wire from the mags, plus another ground wire.

2013 Soaring Youth Grant

The ChicagoLand Glider Council Grant program is hosted under the auspices of the membership of the council and is paid by their dues. A primary grant of \$500 is awarded each year. Other secondary grant(s) may be awarded based on merit. This grant will be paid directly to the recipient's home soaring operation and placed "on account" for use by the recipient for their continuing soaring education.

Application Requirements: The applicant must meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a member in good standing of the ChicagoLand Glider Council as of January 1st, 2013 and,
- Be between the ages of 14 and 21 (inclusive) as of January 1st, 2013 and,
- Reside within 50 miles of Chicago and,
- Did not receive the previous year's \$500 grant (but you might win a secondary grant) and,
- Obtain a written recommendation from a Certified Flight Instructor Glider (CFIG) who is familiar with the applicant's qualifications and,
- Write an original essay of 500-1000 words on "What Soaring Means to Me...." and,
- Send all necessary documentation to the email address <u>and</u> surface mail address shown below <u>no later than</u> midnight, March 1st, 2013.
