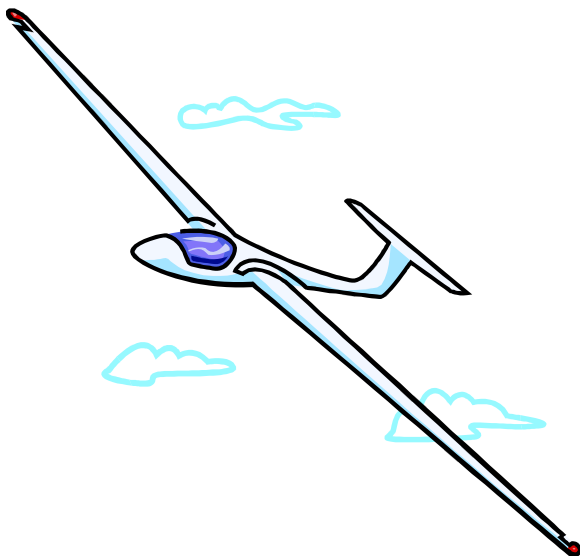

Private Glider Pilot Ground School Begins January 21, 2009

This winter's private glider ground school at McHenry County College will begin on January 21, 2009. It meets from 7:00 until 9:30 for eight weeks. The cost for the class is \$79.00 plus materials. Enrollment is limited! (Only a sales pitch, but it would be a nice problem to have!) Roust out all those relatives, friends and neighbors who have been saying they want to learn to soar. This is their chance. Completion of the class

comes with a sign-off for the written. The last ground school class meeting will be just about the time of our safety seminar. Registration starts Monday, January 5. There is no age requirement and no additional fee for out-of-district enrollments.

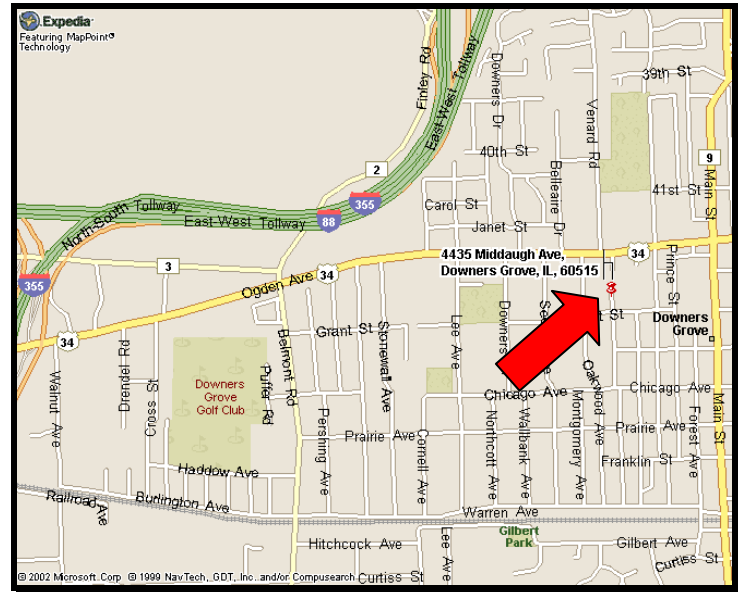

2009 Soaring Youth Grant

The ChicagoLand Glider Council Grant program is hosted under the auspices of the membership of the council and is paid by their dues. A grant of **\$500** will be paid directly to the recipient's home soaring operation and placed "on account" for use by the recipient for their continuing soaring education.

Application Requirements: The applicant must meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a member in good standing of the ChicagoLand Glider Council as of January 1st, 2009 and,
- Be between the ages of 14 and 21 (inclusive) as of January 1st, 2009 and,
- Reside within 100 miles of Chicago and,
- Did not receive the previous year's primary grant and,
- Obtain a written recommendation from a Certified Flight Instructor Glider (CFIG) who is familiar with the applicant's qualifications and,
- Write an original typed essay of 500-1000 words on "What Soaring Means to Me...." and,
- Send all necessary documentation to the email address and the surface mail address shown below **no later than midnight, March 1st, 2009.**

The ChicagoLand Glider Council may, at their discretion, present lesser Grants to worthy applicants.
